Review/Approve of May 17, 2016 meeting minutes: Approved as written by Krista Tegland and Seconded by Molly Beckmann. Motion carried and approved.

- 1. Update/discussion on Tree Town Music festival:
- a) 2 audits performed by Waldorf students (see completed handouts)
- b) 400 postcards sent out. 50 signs placed prior to festival.
- c) Feedback to provide to Tree Town Festival:
