This is through Peers Association. Jason suggested that maybe Waldorf and the coalition could get a deal if two events were held on the same day.
  - a. Reality Check name of website
  - b. Real prizes

  - e. <u>IF</u> this is something the coalition would like in on thoughts for funding include asking the schools or writing a grant to Diamond Joe Casino in Northwood.

- 2. Prairie Ridge received a grant for the education of adults and youth around vaping. A community night was suggested.
